Instructions for Authors

Znakovi vremena (Signs of the Time) is the scientific and research-based journal of the Institute "Ibn Sina" in Sarajevo, which is published biannually. It focuses primarily on original scientific papers within the field of theology, philosophy and religion. The journal also focuses on other scholarly disciplines related to history, social sciences, literature and international relations. The journal publishes reports and papers from scientific symposia (proceedings) which cover the aforementioned scientific and theoretical areas, as well as proclamations/communications, evaluations, reviews, bibliographies and, exceptionally, translations of works by foreign authors.

The Editorial Board accepts only unpublished manuscripts. The manuscripts are submitted via e-mail. The Board maintains the right to adapt the texts to the standards of the journal and to proof-read them in order to ensure compliance with standards of the Bosnian, Croatian and Serbian language. Manuscripts will not be returned.

***Znakovi vremena (Signs of the Time)* publishes the following categories of papers:**

1. Original scientific paper;
2. Preliminary Communication;
3. Review Papers;
4. Professional Papers;
5. Evaluations (4 to 8 pages of text with exact bibliographical data of the evaluated work).

The category of the work is proposed by the author, whereas the final decision will be made by the Editorial Board at the suggestion of two reviewers.

All manuscripts should be prepared according to the APA Publication Manual (7th Edition), whereas books, journal articles, websites and all other types of references should follow the APA Publication Manual (7th Edition). Papers which do not follow this style of citation will not be accepted.

The paper should contain the following:

1. The full title of the paper;
2. The full name of the author(s);
3. The author's academic title;
4. The author's institutional affiliation;
5. The corresponding author's e-mail address and phone number;
6. Abstract and key words in Bosnian, Croatian, Serbian;
7. Abstract and key words in English;
8. Notes and references.

The manuscripts can hold up to maximum 15 (28,000 characters) pages of text.
